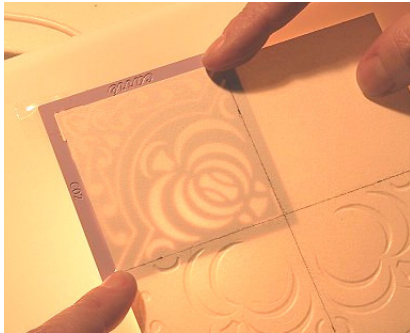
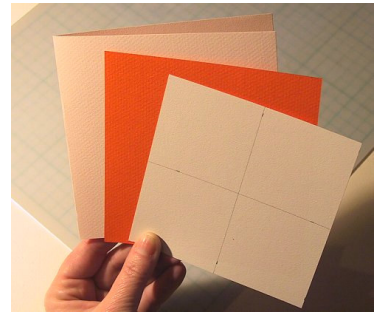


WORKSHOP CARRÉ EMBOSSING

- Cut a white card 12 x 12 cm.
- Cut an orange card 13 x 13 cm.
- Cut a double light-orange card 13,5 x 13,5 cm.
- Draw at the reverse side of the white card 4 equal squares 6 x 6 cm.



- Secure the Carré-template to the light-box.
- Put the 90-degrees reference-corners from the template equal with one of the four squares.
- Secure the card upside down with template-tape to the template and the light-box.
- Emboss the outer corner totally and just a part of the inner corner (see example).
- Embossing is done by pressing the card with the embossing stylus carefully into the illuminated contours of the template.

- Turn the card a quarter and emboss the same parts. Do this two times more.

- Put the embossed card with the right side up on the cutting mat.
- Put the template on the card and secure it with Scotch removable tape.
- Cut both of the cutting lines in the template. Do this with a sharp and a upright craft knife.
- Take each time the same side of the cutting line.
- Do this four times.
- Another possibility is to draw the cutting lines with a pencil and cut it by hand.



- Stick the orange square to the double card.
- Stick on this all the embossed parts.
- Cut out the 3D-pictures en stick this to the card with 3D-foam.
